2) Work Bond of \$50 for all Families, Travel and Instructional

Jan 2012 -

- Approved \$50 per season, details to be worked out, effective September 2012.
- \$50 per season per family, though work hours will be per child in the club in addition to hours required at the Tournament per player not family.
- Little Kickers parents will not be required to submit work bond.

May 2012 Update:

- BoD agreed to defer implementation to Spring 2012 at the earliest. Details not sufficient for Fall 2012 start. Tom Roberts suggested a small committee form to organize format and how best to execute.
- Tom Roberts & Mike DeSordi to work up proposal and rules
- Suggestions were made to review Hillsborough and Hunterdon Central PopWarner Along with West Windsor Plainsboro Soccer Club

August Update: There are now 4 members: GLF, CE, JW, and Jeff Karibinchak **Sept Update**: The VP of Monroe has offered to help and discuss what they are doing **October Update**: Reviewed the Charter prepared by GLF. Proposed Timeline is:

- 3 committee meetings in Oct Nov
- Publish Program Doc in Dec
- BoD approval to pilot in Jan 2014
- Pilot program with instructional registration in Spring 2014
- BoD approval for full rollout in Mar 2014
- Work Bond implemented for Fall registration in May 2014

November Update: Group is still meeting. Still on target for spring pilot rollout.

December Update: General discussion. Still on target for spring pilot rollout for instructional.

January Update: George LF provided copies of his Bond Proposal, long discussion ensued on same. Amount of Bond is to be \$50 per family per Season. Motion by C Erdman to approve with comments and adjustments at meeting. 2nd by Jeff S. Vote 10-0-1 approved. George LF to submit with changes for final approval by Evote by Saturday 1/25/14. To be Piloted this Spring by Instructional.

EVOTE on Work Bond ended 2/2/2014 - APPROVED 8-0-3

February Update: Looking at different web sites to manage work-bonds

March Update: Discussed work-bond sign-up procedures, web-site being set up for parents to select work items

- 3) Winter Futsal in PHS Gyms run by club for club only Chuck Myers July 2013 Update:
 - Still in planning stages. Chuck to submit request form to Board of Ed to reserve HS Gym
 - Anticipated games dates will be available Sundays in Jan, Feb, and Mar

October Update: Proposal discussed. Motion to run internal Futsal league by JS, second by CE, passed 11-0-0.

- GLF will survey all coaches
- · Chuck to write up an initial announcement with details for distribution to parents/coaches.
- Survey of 14 Instructional + 20 Travel teams revealed that 11 teams were initially interested.
- Registration is due 12/15

November Update: Only 5 teams have notified Chuck that they will register (U7, U7, U8G, U10B, U10G). Deadline is 12/15. GLF indicated that many teams were not signing up as they wanted to play against other clubs. MM to reach out to other local clubs to determine if there is any interest.

December Update: We have received interest from 14 teams **January Update:** We are a GO!

- Will use Patton Gym for 5 of 6 weeks (chuck scheduling with HS)
- The dates can still be Sundays 1/26, 2/2-9-16-23, and 3/2. Setup 11-12, play 12-4
- Registration is \$120 per PSC team, and a discounted fee of \$300 per team outside club Motion by CE, 2nd by JS to spend up to \$1,000 for equipment for the winter futsal program. Vote APPROVED 10-0-1

February Update: Have played for 4 of the 6 weeks. No major complaints. **March Update:** Last games played on 3/2. Everything went well. **CLOSED**

4) Instructional Tournament with Kohl's as sponsor – Chuck Myers looking into this.

November Update: A draft proposal document is written (sent out separately after meeting). For the inaugural tournament, the initial goal is to get a small number of teams (~50 teams + our rec teams). There are some challenges:

- How to Market? Will have to call the Club President. Traditional Advertisement (newspaper/radio/cable using community announcement)
- Player / Team verification without player passes / team roster. Must rely on honesty of clubs
- Volunteers? Use Instructional Work Bond program
- Food/Drink bring in a vendor for the day
- Ambulance/EMT reach out to other large hospitals (e.g., Somerset Med Center)
- Use existing Spring small sided fields, but need to build Micro fields as same site/GA.

Chuck to send out proposal. (not sent yet) **December Update:** Tabled.

January Update: Tabled (chuck hasn't had time to devote to this project).

February Update: planned date is Saturday, June 14th

 See separate proposal. Discussed changing the date to Sunday 6/15 (Father's day), Memorial Day weekend, Sunday 6/8, Sunday 6/22 (after school is out) Motion by CM second by JS to apply and host a recreation tour sponsored by Kohl's, passed by a vote of 11-0-0

March Update: We received a rejection letter from US Youth Soccer. They are limiting the number of events to 45 throughout the country and we were not selected. **CLOSED**

5) **Friday night Free-Play Pick-Up Games –** GLF proposed setting up a pick-up game in the Spring for any players looking for additional soccer. This could conflict with Goal Keeper training.

December Update: To Trial this in spring on Instructional fields

January Update: Proceeding, No Details yet, Instructional Coaches are interested per GLF. **February Update:** Discussed holding this at the HS Stadium on the turf field without the lights

March Update: Coaches think it is a great idea

6) **Saturday 5v5 Games –** GLF proposed setting up an environment for a U9 (or older) team to split into two teams and then play another PSC team in two 5v5 games. No refs, no additional fees. Would require that a couple of 5v5 fields be built and maintained.

December Update: The intent is to join other clubs and run 5v5 festivals (similar to what Princeton is

involved with)

February Update: GLF will contact nearby clubs to run 3 festivals (e.g., Edison, Highland Park,

Metuchen)

March Update: Targeted for U8-U11 teams, on a Saturday for 2-3 hours. A normal team would split

into 2 sub-teams and play three 5v5 games.

7) **Registration Payment Options** – Gina LF proposed different registration payment options for Travel, this based on some feedback given to her. The following are examples for discussion purposes.

- One payment for both Fall and Spring seasons 1 x \$360
- (existing) Two payments, one for Fall, one for Spring seasons 2 x \$200
- Four (4) payments for both Fall and Spring 4 x \$400

Of concern is that the club would have to pay additional credit card fees for every transaction (up to 3%?) thus the additional multiple payments should be higher to cover the additional fees incurred by the club.

8) **Travel Team Tryouts for Fall/Spring 2014-2015** – PEC draft of was reviewed and discussed. Board members are requested to send comments/concerns to the PEC Chairman. Draft is attached.

January Update: See Tom R's marked up copy sent by email. Tryouts will be held over 2 days if the number of players permit same. Motion by George R to approve Procedures with comments by TR and Tryouts to be held over 2 days if the number of players permit same. 2nd by Jeff S, Vote APPROVED by 10-0-0

February Update: Discussed the process to contact parents after tryouts. Jeff, Mike, Mark volunteered to make phone calls to parents to help the PEC get information out to parents quickly. Will use the HS turf and GA grass fields (example: Week 1 – boys on turf, girls on grass, Week 2 – switch) to provide appropriate sized fields. Discussed tryout week dates (2 from 5/5, 5/12, 5/19).

- 9) Jeff Sundelof Wants to run an Instructional Coaches Clinic on Friday March 17 on the Turf.
- 10) George Louis-Ferdinand Discussed a Development program for older recreation players (U13+) to continue training in a group, with hopes that they can join a travel team.

March Update: Discussed MNJ ability to roster up to 22 players but only suit-up 18 per game. Subsequent EVOTE called for to allow roster of 22 players for our U13 bottom flight team. EVote that ended 4/14 was a tie 3-3-5 (for-against-abstain) with the President voting No to break the tie. Did Not Pass. CLOSED

11) George Louis-Ferdinand – Feedback from the Travel Coach's Meeting, coaches want a 3 ref team for small sided games instead of a single ref. Other towns use 3 refs for U9-U10 games. BH suggested that we send an email to our region's ref assignor and request 3 refs.
